

HUNTER DEFINITIONS

BEGINNER RIDER - Open to riders of any age that has not been showing for more than 2 years.

NOVICE EQUITATION - Open to riders of any age that have not won 3 blue ribbons.

LEADLINE - Open to riders 8 and under as of Jan. 1, of current year. May cross enter into Mini Stirrup ONLY.

MINI STIRRUP EQUITATION - Open to riders 10 and under as of Jan. 1, of current year.

OPEN W/T EQUITATION - Open to riders of all ages.

SHORTEST STIRRUP EQUITATION - Open to riders 12 and under as of Jan. 1, of current year.

SHORT/LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION - Short Stirrup is riders 14 and under as of Jan. 1, of current year. Long Stirrup is riders from 14 to 16 years as of Jan. 1, of current year. Will split ages if there are 3 per age group.

ADULT RIDER EQUITATION - Open to beginning riders over the age of 18 as of Jan. 1, of current year.

NOVICE HUNTER - Open to horses and ponies in their first or second year of showing. May trot on course.

CROSSRAIL HUNTER - Open to the eternal crossrail horse. Horse may not be entered to jump in any vertical jumping classes.

SCHOOLING HUNTER (2') - Class maybe be split by pony size, if there are enough entries.

GREEN HUNTER (2') - Open to horses and ponies in their first or second year of showing. May trot on course.

PLEASURE HORSE/PONY (2') - Open to horses and ponies.

JUNIOR EQUITATION (2') - Open to riders under the age of 18 as of Jan. 1, of current year.

CROSS ROAD TACK MEDAL (2'3") - Open to riders of all ages. Judged on hands, seat and control of mount. Top riders may be asked back for hack.

MODIFIED HUNTER (2'3") - Open to horses and ponies.

LOW HUNTER (2'6") - Open to horses and ponies.

HANDY HUNTER (2'6" UP TO 3') - Open to horses and ponies.

EQUITATION: Rider judged on hands, seat and control of mount.

HUNTER: Horse judged on manner performance and way of going.

CROSS ROAD TACK OTTB AWARD

Awarded to the top pointed Off-Track Thoroughbred for entire series. Must specify on entry if horse is OTTB.

JUMPERS

Table II, Sec I - The first round is decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and the penalties for exceeding time allowed. Horse with clean rounds or equal faults are classified according to their time taken to complete the course.

Cross Road Tack Horse Shows Rules & Info

1. Approved helmets are mandatory for all riders at all times while mounted and exhibitors are to be suitably attired. Formal attire is not required.
2. Management reserves the right to divide, combine, cancel or change the order of classes if necessary. Judge's decision is final.
3. Negative coggins within one year required.
4. Six ribbons will be awarded in each class, with ribbon to the division champion and reserve. Year End Awards will be awarded at the September Show. Exhibitors must participate in at least 3 out of 5 shows to qualify for Year-End Awards.
5. If you cannot leave your dog at home, please keep it on a leash.
6. All Cross Road Tack Shows are run in accordance with current USEF rules.
7. There is a \$3 grounds fee per horse showing, and \$15 for Non-Showing Horses.
